## **Upon Arrival**

### **Arrival by air:**

Public transportation into town/hotel:

Take bus line "F" – which takes you to the „Terminal“.

(Bus Timetable: <http://www.ivb.at/downloads/kursbuch/f.pdf>)

Transportation to the Institute:

There is no convenient public transportation available from the airport to the institute, use a Taxi (Telephone: 5311).

### **Arrival by rail:**

Public transportation to the Institute:

Take bus line "R" from the main railway station "Innsbruck Hbf" at Südtirolerplatz (place in front of the railway station) to bus stop "Fürstenweg", change here to bus line "O" which takes you to bus stop "Technikerstrasse". Approaching the south part of the Technical Complex, find the Institute on the left hand side of the Technical Complex.



### Arrival by car:

To town:

Take exit Innsbruck-West or Middle for equivalently easy town access.

To the Institute:

Take exit Innsbruck-Kranebitten for convenient access via the Kranebitter Allee and the junction Technikerstrasse to the Academy, at the University Campus Technikerstrasse 25, which is the last building on the left hand inside of the University Campus, located 4 km west of town just opposite of the airport.

### How to get to the Institute

**by car**

Parking outside of the University area: you have to pay parking taxes (1 Euro/hour)

**by bus – from the hotel/town**

(directions to: "Technik West", "Peerhofsiedlung" or "Allerheiligen"):

The bus line "O" (bus-station opposite the hotel) will take you directly to bus stop **"Technikerstrasse"**

one-way-ticket at the bus driver or day and weekly ticket at the "Trafik"

(newsagent/tobacconist) or at the ticket machine at the bus terminal
